Mom Sells Son's Car After Finding Alcohol

News Summary

An Iowa woman who found alcohol in her son's car placed a classified ad explaining the situation and sold the car, [Fox News](#) reported Jan. 9.

Jane Hamilton said she only had two rules when she gave the 1999 Oldsmobile Intrigue to her 19-year-old son: no alcohol and keep the doors locked. When she found liquor in the car -- which her son said was left there by someone else -- she placed the following ad:

"OLDS 1999 Intrigue. Totally uncool parents who obviously don't love teenage son, selling his car. Only driven for three weeks before snoopy mom who needs to get a life found booze under front seat. \$3,700/offer. Call meanest mom on the planet."

The car was quickly sold, and Hamilton got dozens of calls from emergency-room technicals, school counselors, and others. "It's overwhelming the number of calls I've gotten from people saying "Thank you, it's nice to see a responsible parent," she said. "So far there are no calls from anyone saying, 'You're really strict. You're real overboard, lady.'"
